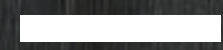

Utah is a mecca for mountain bikers from all over the world. We ride trails that are not only fun, but therapeutic in beauty, serenity, and physical exertion.





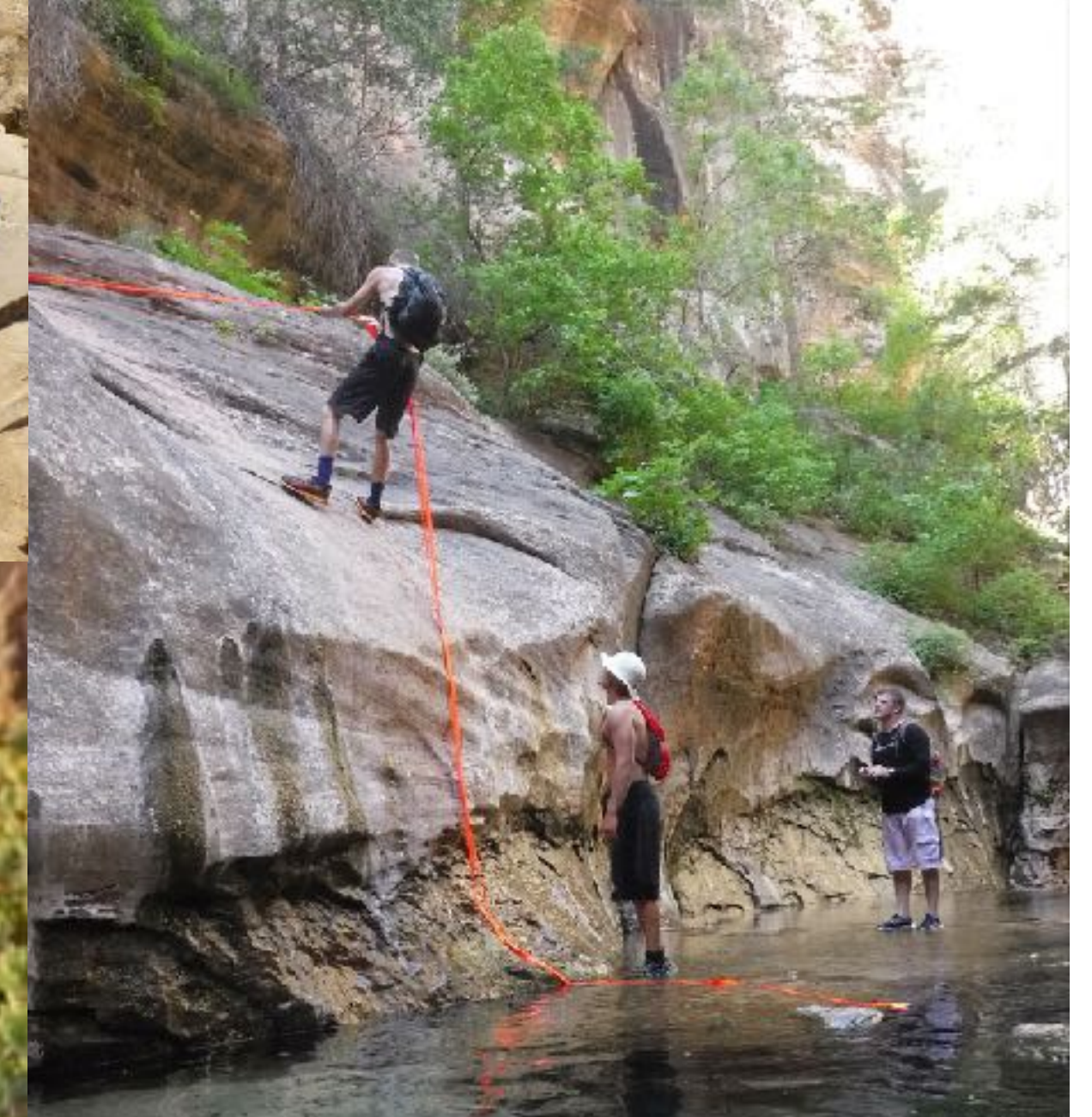
RIVER RAFTING, KAYAKING & WATER FUN

The vast number of slot canyons, rocky ridges, and sandstone cliffs provide outstanding rock climbing, bouldering, and rappelling adventures.



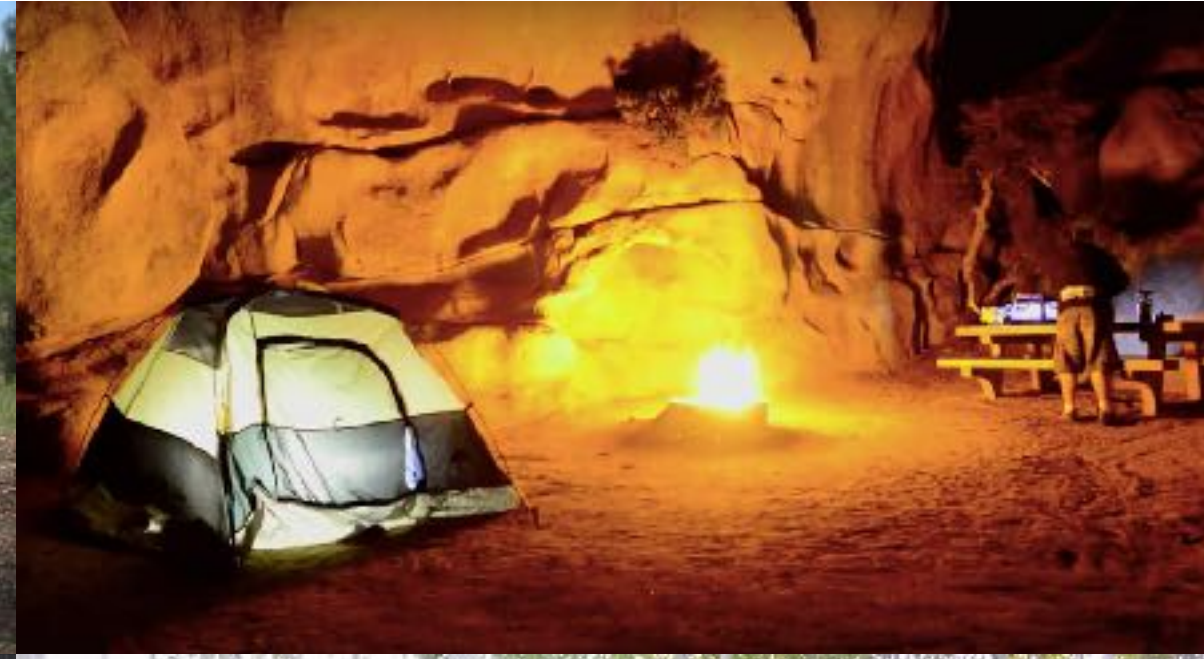


FUN IN THE GREATEST SNOW ON EARTH

Part academic, part experiential therapy, and a whole lot of fun. We take field trips to visit ancient ruins, historical sites, and learn about our cultural heritage.

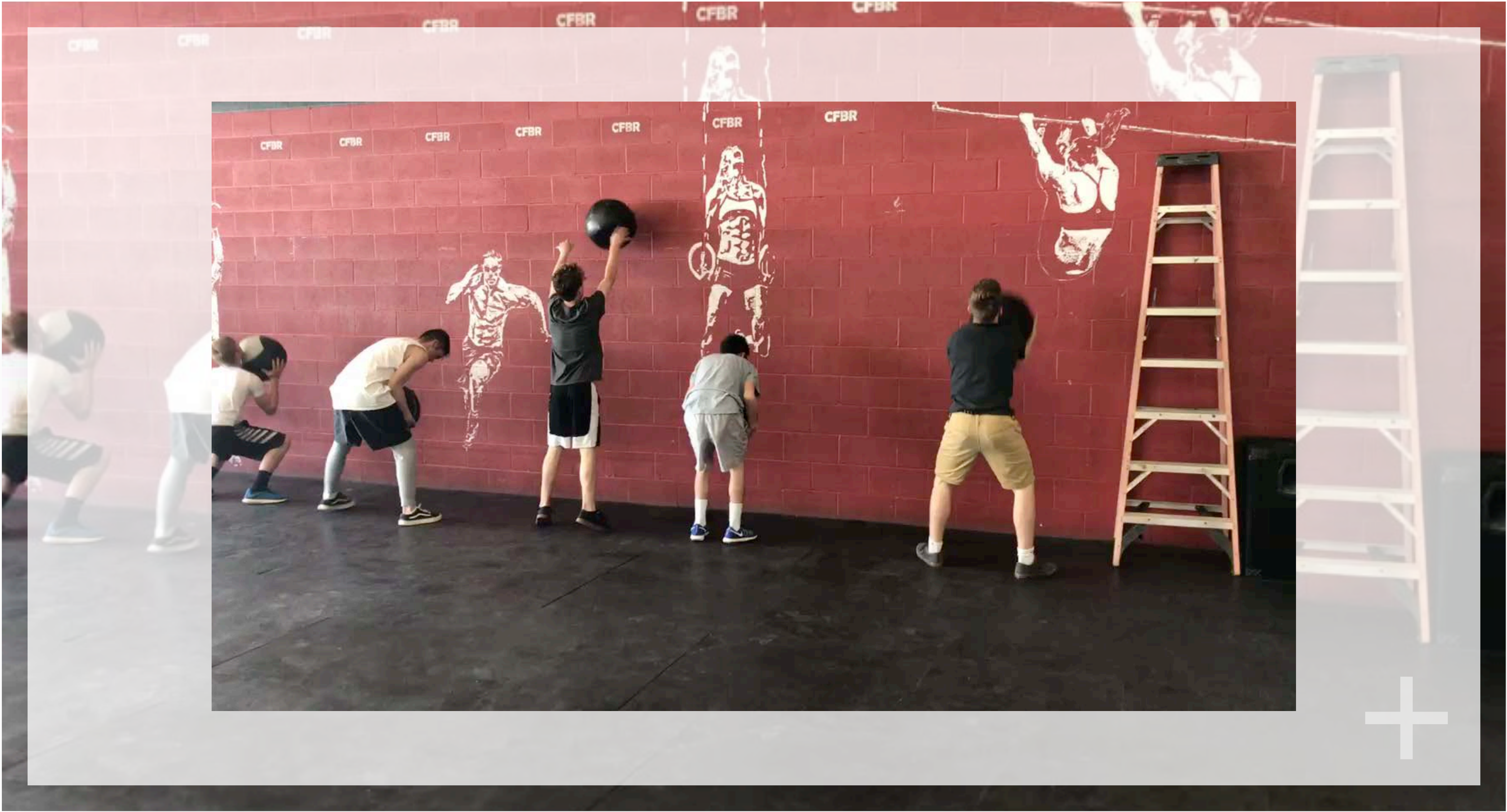




SPORTS, FITNESS & ATHLETICS

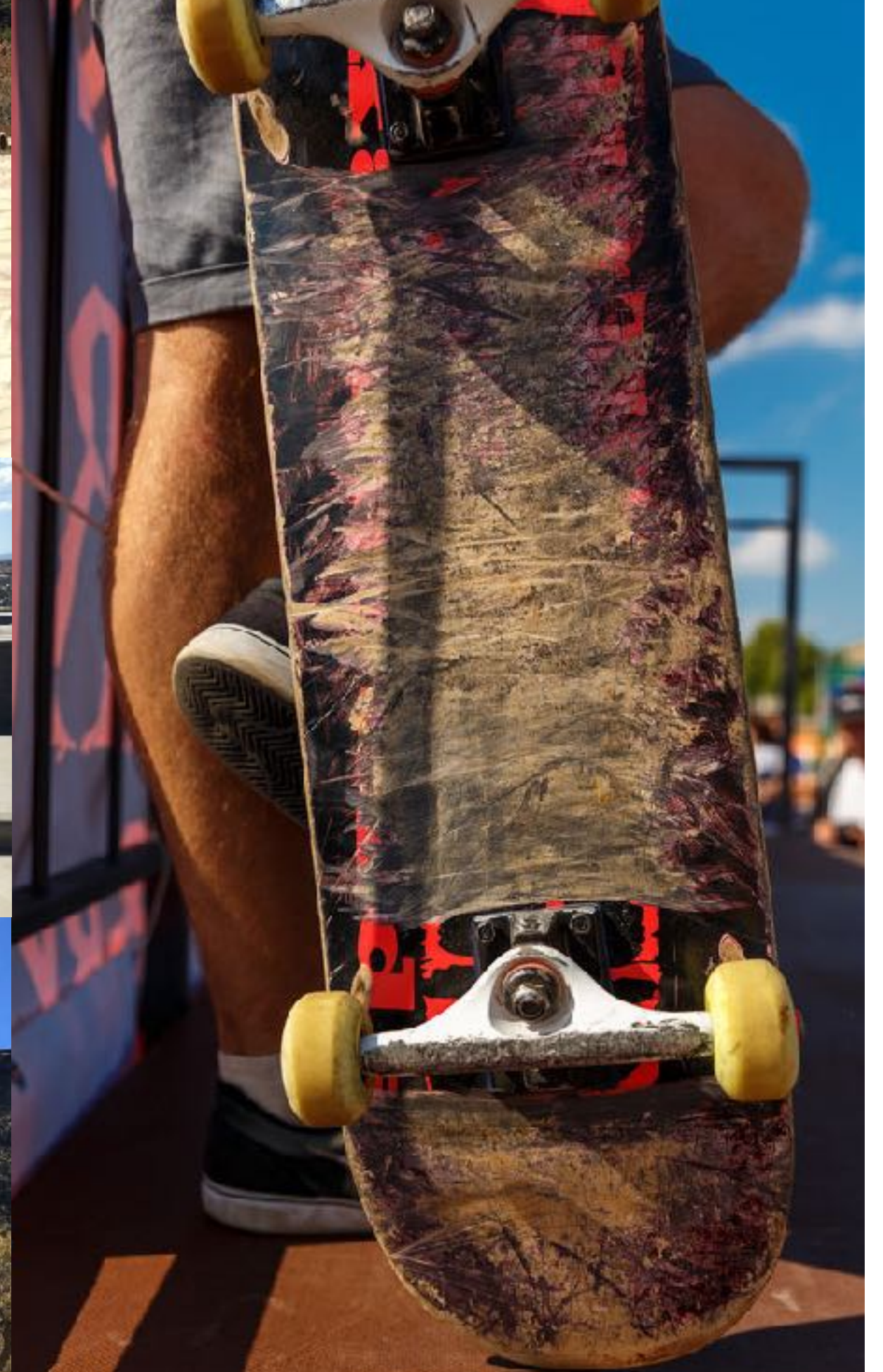






SKATEBOARD RAMP IN OUR OWN BACK YARD

Learning to serve others before one's self is a key part of our program. We provide opportunities to serve the community and the less fortunate in regularly scheduled projects and events.



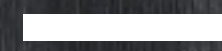


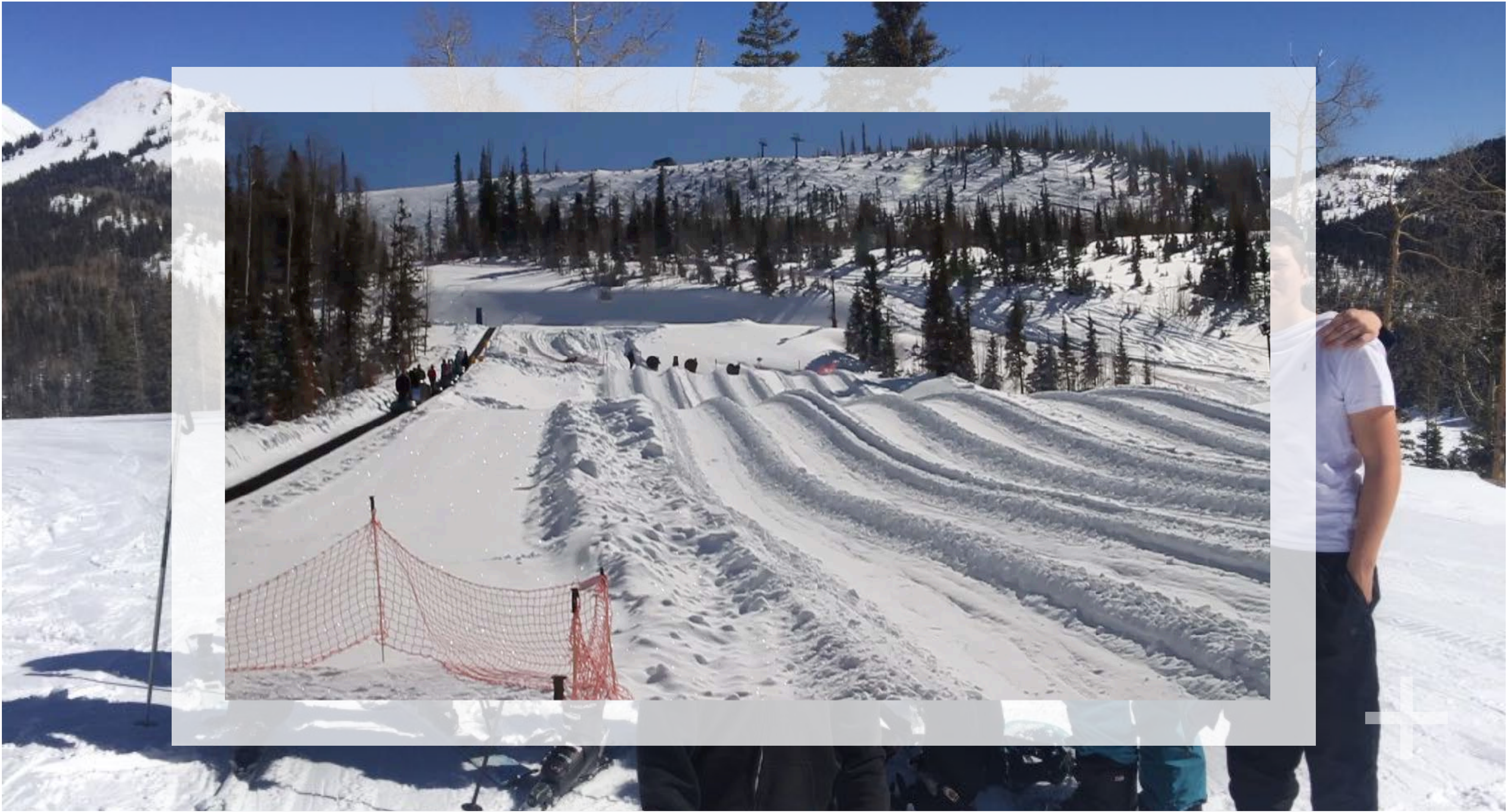

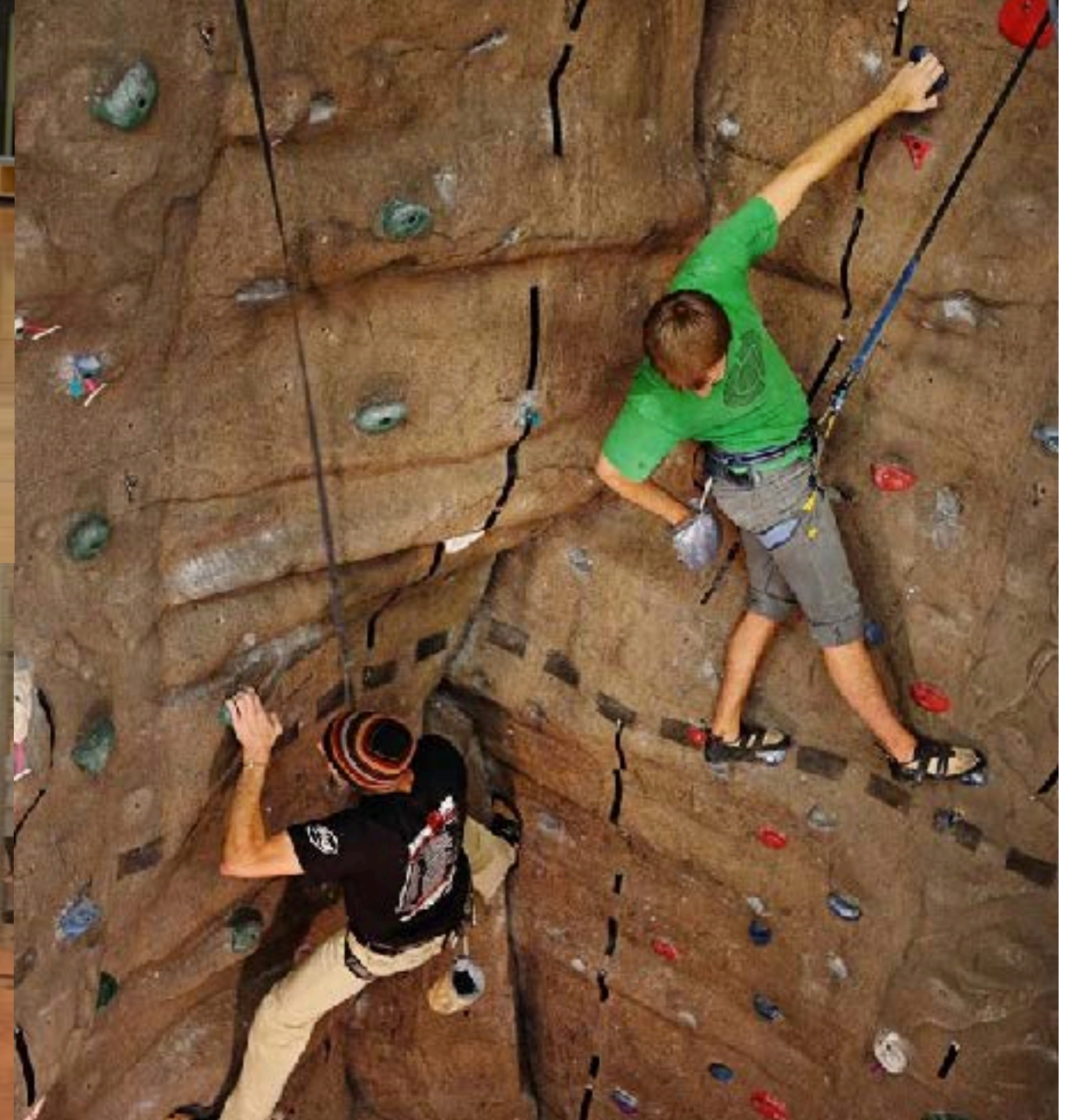






WASHINGTON COMMUNITY MEMBERSHIP

We participate in **city league sports**, fitness, swimming, weight training, indoor rock climbing, basketball, and more through the Washington City Community Center.

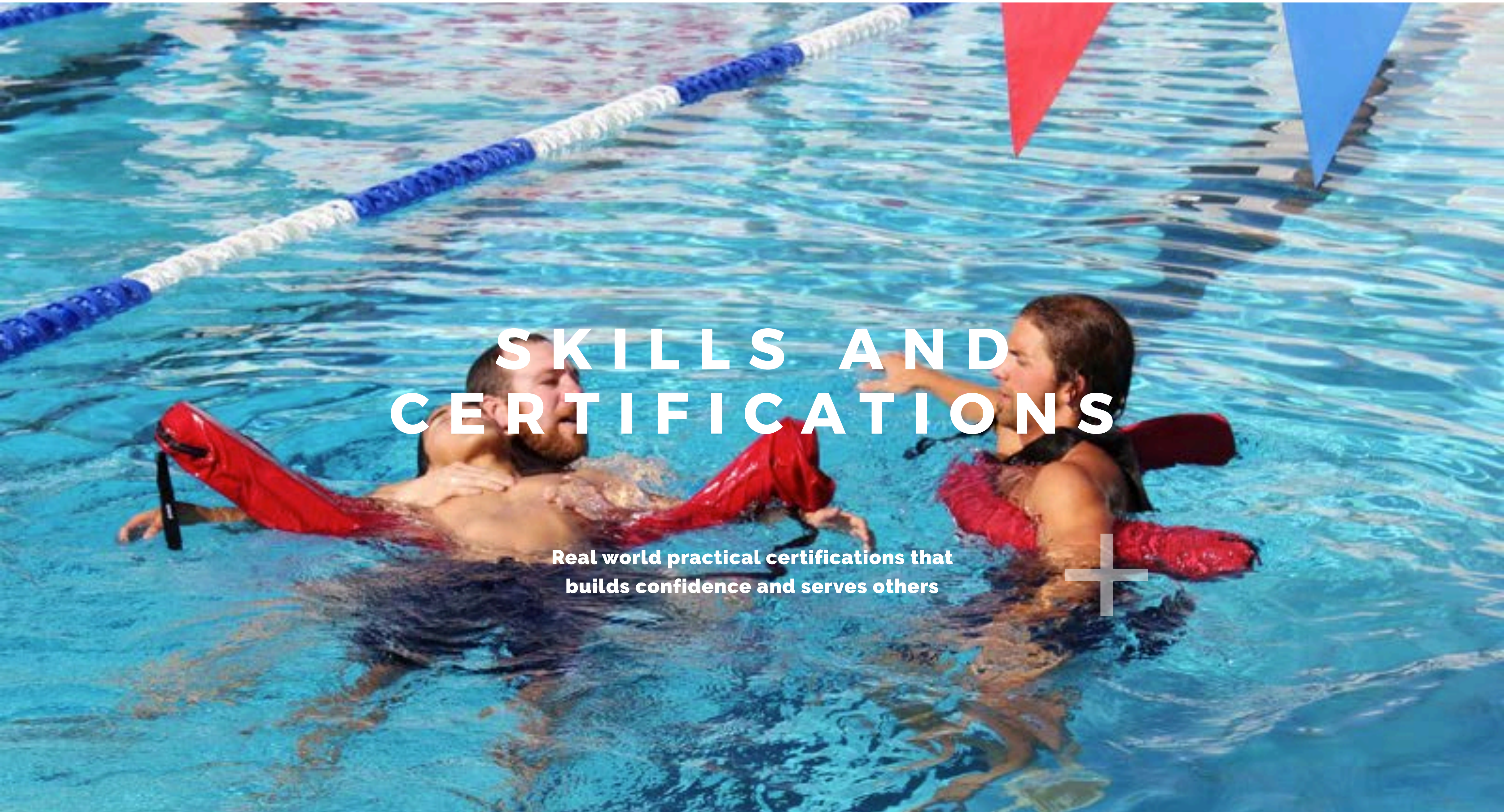
